# Tournament Check in PDT31

**Check in:** Will be held *Pointe Hilton Tapatio Cliffs Resort, 11111 N 7<sup>th</sup> St, Phoenix, AZ 85020*. This is also the tournament headquarters.

**Thursday night February 11<sup>th</sup>:** Check-in from 5 till 10 pm for in state teams and out of state teams that arrive early.

**Friday night the February 12<sup>th</sup>:** Check-in for out of state teams from 5 till 10 pm, and Friday night games for teams requesting a Friday night game. We do not do check in at the field. If you have a Friday night game, you need to get to check in when it opens at 5 and tell them you have 6 pm game. They will take you immediately. The teams can start the game without their passes, but you need to have the passes to the field marshals before halftime. Your team does need to take a copy of their roster to the field and that will serve to get them checked in and playing their game until you get there with the player passes.

At check-in, **USYS teams** from outside Arizona must submit a copy of their “**Permission to Travel**” form and a “**Travel Roster**” with a maximum of 18 players for U12 through U15 and 22 players for U16, U17 and U19 teams. These two (2) forms are mandatory. Please bring two (2) copies of each form as the tournament will be keeping one (1) set.

The Game roster for U16, U17 and U19 cannot include more than 18 players per game, they can however be a different 18 players for each game. Guest players must have a USYS player pass (Cannot play on a USYS team with a US Club Soccer Pass).

At check-in, **US Club Soccer teams** must submit two (2) copies of their “**Official Team Roster**”. The tournament will be keeping one (1) set. Teams are allowed a maximum of 18 players for U12 through U15 and 22 players for U16, U17 and U19 teams. The Game roster for U16, U17 and U19 cannot include more than 18 players per game, they can however be a different 18 players for each game. Guest players must have a US Club Soccer pass (Cannot play with a USYS pass on a U S Club Soccer team).

**Passes** are required of all players and coaches. Passes must be laminated or enclosed in a clear sealed packet.

**Medical Release Forms** Medical release forms are supplied by you and are issued by your state. These are the medical release forms that you use for league and tournament play. These forms are required by all players under the age of 18.

**Birth Certificates are not required.**

**Loan Players:** If you are using a loan player, the loan player must appear on the state **Travel Roster**, or your **U S Club Roster**. If your state **requires** you to use a loan player form, you must supply those at check in also. A medical release form and player pass are required for tournament play.

**The President' Day Tournament** does not issue any forms specific to our tournament. If you have any questions about any of the above forms, please contact your State Association or U S Club Soccer representative.
